



Get TCEP X Posts Pushed to Your Mobile Phone



The only way to get TCEP notifications and verified incident updates pushed to your phone is through X. You must have an X account, but if you don't want to use X for anything other than TCEP notifications, you can choose to only follow TCEP. Think of X as another part of your emergency kit. Consider also following @LACoFD_DivVII (LA County Fire Division 7) and @LACoFDPIO (LA County Fire Public Information Officer). When you see a TCEP post about an incident, go to tcep.org/emergencystatus for more details.

1. Download the X app. If you don't have an X account, create one.
2. Log in to your X account and search for **@TCEP90290**. Once on TCEP's profile page, tap the **Follow** button.
3. Tap the **bell icon** to the left of the **Follow** button. Tap **All posts**.
4. Navigate back to your own profile page (tap your **profile icon** or the three lines depending on your device OS).
5. Scroll down and tap **Settings and privacy** then tap **Preferences**, then tap **Notifications**.
6. Tap **Push Notifications** then tap **Posts**. If you don't want anything else from X, turn off all of the other options (you might want to leave Crisis and emergency alerts turned on).
7. Go to your phone settings and select how you want push notifications from X to be displayed.

The above settings will push ALL TCEP X posts to your phone. TCEP respects your privacy and limits posts during calm conditions.
